

Third Grade Homework Policy

1. Homework should become part of your child's daily routine. Find a quiet workspace for your child to complete his/her homework.
2. Encourage and motivate your child to complete the homework independently but be there to guide them as needed.
3. Homework should take no longer than 30 minutes to complete. If your child is spending more than 30 minutes, please contact the teacher.
4. No homework will be given on Fridays, breaks and holidays, and during PARCC testing.
5. Third grade teachers strongly recommend that each child read or be read to at least 15 minutes per night.
6. As a reward for completing and turning in homework on time, students will be eligible to participate in monthly homework reward parties. Students who have turned in all of their homework on time will be able to enjoy the full one hour party. Students with 3-5 late or incomplete homework assignments will be able to enjoy 30 minutes of the party. Students with 6 or more late assignments will not participate in the party, and will spend the time silently reading or finishing missing work.
